## Friday Night Couples League Rules for 2010

1. League plays eleven Friday nights over sixteen weeks that includes one week scheduled for make up matches due to weather.
  - FIRST NIGHT OF PLAY: May 14<sup>th</sup>
  - NO PLAY: May 28<sup>th</sup> (Memorial Day weekend)  
July 2<sup>nd</sup> (Fourth of July weekend)  
August 6<sup>th</sup> (Men's Member Guest weekend)  
August 13<sup>th</sup> (Ladies' Member Guest weekend)  
September 3<sup>rd</sup> (Labor Day weekend)
  - MAKEUP MATCHES: August 27<sup>th</sup>
  - PLAYOFFS START: September 10<sup>th</sup>
  - BANQUET: October 1<sup>st</sup>
2. DIVISIONS:
  - League teams are divided into two divisions of eleven teams.
  - Due to the odd number of teams in each division, each team will have a bye week during which they will not have a scheduled match.
3. TEAMS:
  - Two person teams consisting of one man and one woman (marriage optional, divorce possible).
4. COST: \$60 per team.
  - All players must be paid prior to first night of play.
5. PLAYERS:
  - All players must have an established and current GHIN handicap.
  - If you don't have an established GHIN, you must sign up for one at the pro shop prior to the start of league.
  - If your GHIN handicap is not fully established by the first night of play, your handicap will be assigned based on what you score.
  - Max **9-hole** handicap **without** an established GHIN will be 15 for men and 20 for women.
6. ELIGIBILITY:
  - Any adult (18+) member of PVCC
  - Any adult (18+) non-member with a current GHIN handicap
7. START TIMES:
  - Between 4:00 pm and 5:30 pm.
  - Please notify your opponents as soon as possible if you will be later than your regular time.
8. SUBSTITUTES:
  - Substitutes may be used if a player has a scheduling conflict.
  - If a substitute is obtained, the team must notify the pro shop in advance of the scheduled league night in order to properly assign handicap strokes to the card.
  - As a courtesy, please notify the opposing team, as well.
  - Substitute Eligibility:
    - Any adult member of PVCC can be a sub.
    - A non-member can sub, but must have a current GHIN handicap.
    - PVCC member subs are allowed in the playoffs if the match cannot be rescheduled.
    - No non-member subs are allowed in the playoffs.

9. RESCHEDULING A MATCH:

- If both members of a team cannot play on the scheduled date and you cannot find substitutes, you can attempt to reschedule the match during the week **between the date in conflict and the next** league night. You **CANNOT** make up a match before the matches scheduled date.
- If you are unable to reschedule and have no subs, then your team cannot earn points for that week. The opposing team plays against the course to earn points for the week.

10. RULES OF PLAY:

- USGA and PVCC local rules apply.
- Ball hit into the woods off the 10th tee:  
NO PROVISIONAL. If ball cannot be found, take a drop on wood line at the point of entry.  
One stroke penalty

11. FORMATS: match play alternating each week between

- Best Ball
- Scramble
- Chapman Scotch

12. HANDICAPPING:

- Half strokes apply.
- Best Ball: 90% based off low handicap in foursome
- Scramble: Difference between the low handicaps on each team divided by 2 and then multiplied by 90%.
- Scotch: Difference between combined team handicaps multiplied by 25%

13. POINTS:

- Win a hole = 2 points
- Tie a hole = 1 point
- Attendance = 1 point per player
- Total = 22 points per match

14. POSTING SCORES:

- Each player shall post 9-hole scores on nights when the format is Best Ball.

15. PLAYOFFS:

- Top 8 point getting teams make the playoffs (equal # from each division).
- Format: 3-3-3 (Three holes Best Ball, Three holes Scramble, Three holes Chapman Scotch)
